## EXPERIENCE CLASSES

In the recent combined class held on January 6, members were asked to complete a Spiritual Health Assessment. For the next few weeks, Many of the adult classes will be embark on an in depth study related to the questions in the assessment. Celebrate Recovery is a confidential Bible-based recovery program that offers support and hope for the hurts, habits and hang-ups of life.

Are you or someone you know struggling with alcoholism, divorce, sexual abuse, codependency, domestic violence, drug addiction, sexual addiction, food addiction, gambling addiction or similar issue?

There are several features that make Celebrate Recovery (CR) unique:

1. CR is based on God's Word, the Bible. The Beatitudes contain eight principles that are God's road to recovery, wholeness, growth and spiritual maturity.
2. CR is forward-looking. Regardless of what has already happened, the solution is to start making wise choices now depending on Christ's power.
3. CR emphasizes personal responsibility. The healing power of Christ can begin working in us when we stop hiding our faults and blaming others.
4. CR emphasizes a personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
5. CR utilizes the biblical truth that we need each other to grow spiritually and emotionally.
